Subject: - Clearance of side-drains and culverts

Before the rainy season sets-in, it is imperative that all the road-side drains and culverts are cleared and are made effectively functional.

To achieve the above objective, the following strategy be adopted:-

Sub-Divisions where adequate labour(say more than 0.75 beldar/Km) are available, the departmental labour be deployed.

In addition to above the departmental JCBs(with small 30 cm bucket, which can be procured (if not available) can also be deployed where either the new drain has to be dug or the existing kucha drain has considerably vanished.

The Superintending Engineers concerned should get their guideline implemented in their Circles and ensure that all drains/culverts are cleared by 20th June,2012, and submit the report on following format :-
