In continuation of this department letter NO. PBW(B&R)(B)-17(1)3/2006 dated 1st Feb. 2008 and to refer your letter No. PW-CTR-32-20/Gen.Instr./2012-11039 dated 15/09/2012 on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that the matter of awarding not more than two works of Rs 1.00 Crore each to the contractor bidding for State Budget/Budgeted/NABARD works as stipulated in Para (vii) of this Department letter of even No. Dated 01-02-2008 was under consideration. Now it has been decided to replace the said condition with the bidding capacity of the contractors for state Budgeted/NABARD works having amount put to tender as Rs. Fifty Lacs (50.00Lacs) or more by deleting/removing the bar for not bidding more than two contracts. The bidder's bidding capacity shall be assessed by the formula proposed in your above quoted letter of dated 15.09.2012. You are therefore requested to take further action accordingly.

With reference to above mentioned letter the following formula is proposed for assessing the bidding capacity of the bidder for State Budgeted /NABARD works having amount put to tender as 50.00 lacs or more:-

BIDDING CAPACITY OF CONTRACTORS FOR STATE BUDGETED/NABARD WORKS:-

Bidders who meet the minimum qualification criteria will be qualified only if their assessed available bid capacity for construction works is equal to or more than the amount put to tender. The available bid capacity will be calculated as under:

Assessed Available Bid capacity = (A*N*M - B)where

A =Maximum value of civil engineering works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to the price level of the financial year in which bids are received at the rate of 8 percent a year) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N =Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which bids are invited (period up to 6 months to be taken as half-year and more than 6 months as one year).

M =2

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B=Value, at the current price level, of ongoing works on-going works to be completed during the period of completion of the works for which bids are invited.

Note: The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Engineer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent.

This bidding capacity for state budgeted /NABARD works has been proposed for review of restriction of two works circulated vide your office letter no PBW(B)17(3)1/2006 Dt 27.05.2011. As such consequent upon adoption of bidding capacity assessment formula, there shall be no necessity to continue the restriction of two works as above.
